



Place 5 Queens on the following mini chess board so that no Queen is under attack from any other.




# 2. Twenty Five Queens: 5 times as difficult?




#### 3. Cantor Dust

Use the covering method to determine the dimension of the Middle Thirds Cantor Set.




# 4. The Sierpinski Triangle: 1-D or 2-D? You make the call.
