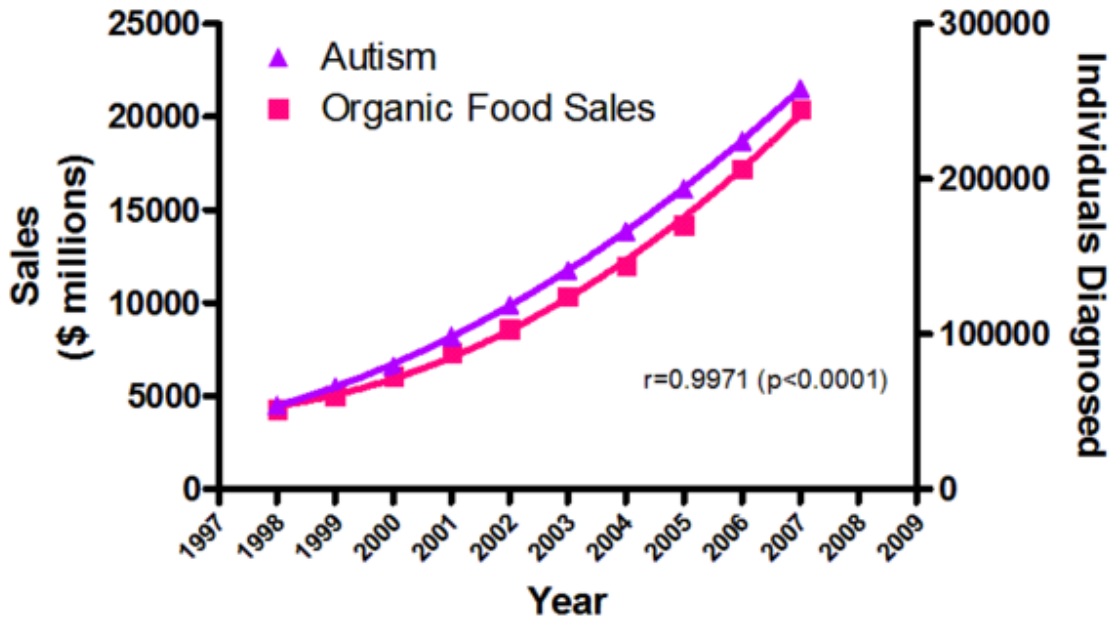
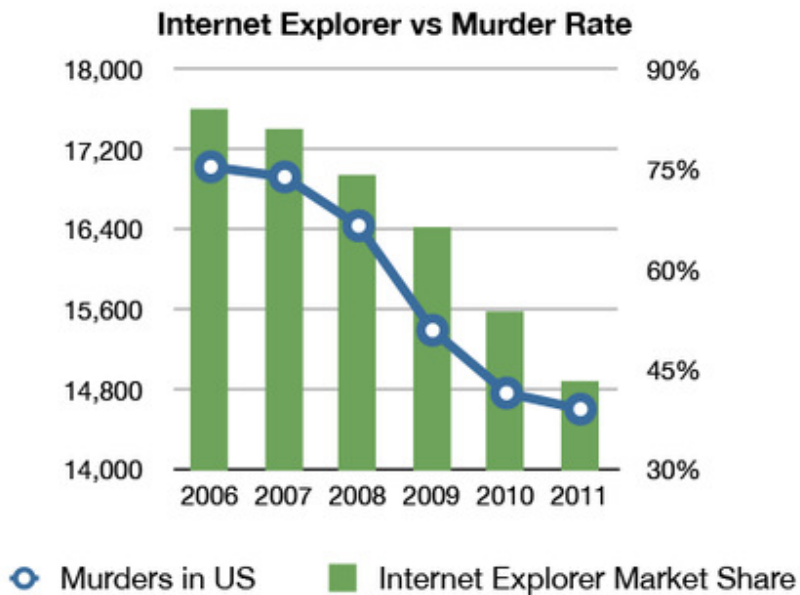

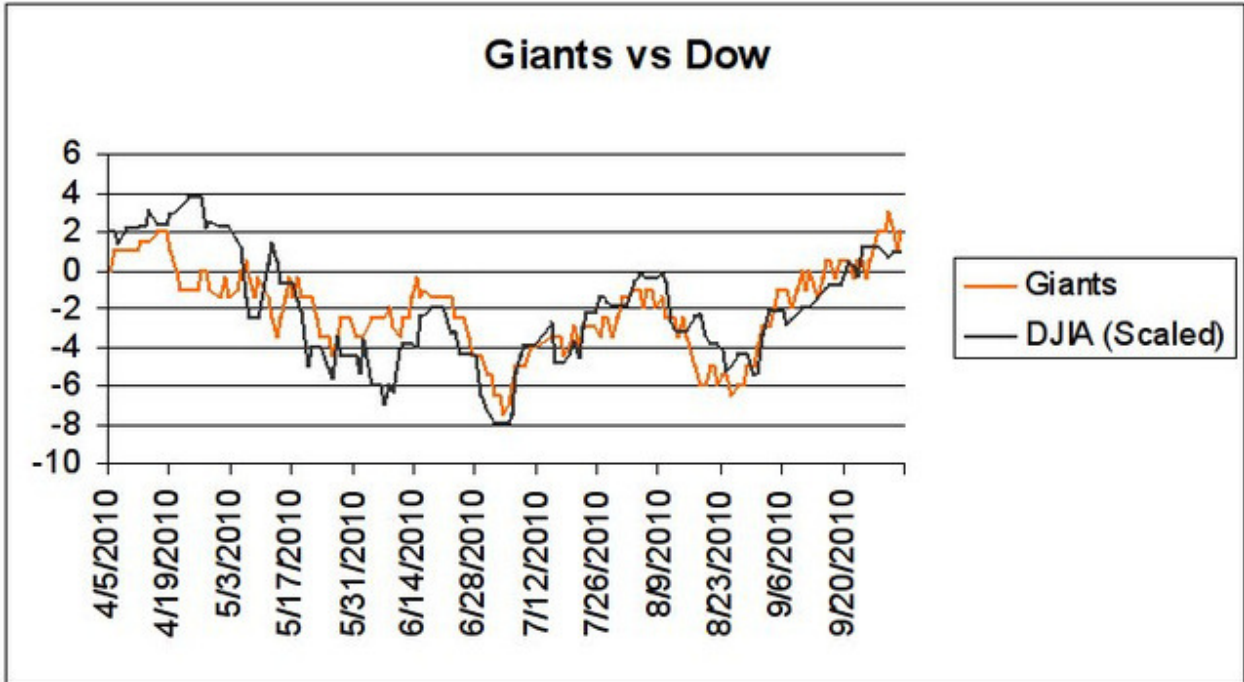
The real cause of increasing autism prevalence?
